

**Local Rule # 15 - Distance Measuring Devices**

For all play at our courses, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures **distance only**. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, direction etc.), the player is in breach of USGA Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
